Farhat Yusuf is an Emeritus Professor of demography in the Faculty of Business and Economics at Macquarie University, and also an Honorary Professor of public health in the Menzies Centre for Health Policy at the University of Sydney.

He has a long history of teaching and research on population and health related matters in both Australia and overseas. He has held visiting appointments in prestigious institutions such as Princeton University and Cornell University in United States, City University and the University of Southampton in United Kingdom, and the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences. He has also been a consultant at various international organisations including the UN Population Fund, the UN Development Programme, and the International Agency for Research on Cancer.

Professor Yusuf has co-authored four books – most recent being *Consumer Demographics and Behaviour* and *Methods of Demographic Analysis* – published in 2013 and 2015 respectively. His research papers have appeared in refereed journals such as *Population Research and Policy Review*, *Journal of Biosocial Science*, *Journal of Public Health*, *Australian and New Zealand Journal of Obstetrics & Gynaecology* and the *Medical Journal of Australia*.
